Angola except the 61 beneficiary countries of the new rule for visa on arrival, please see the bottom of the document; You need to secure visas, even when in transit. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in unnecessary inconvenience including deportation. Please ensure proper connection with your agency and fulfills the requirements before starting trip .

Description Country

Angola is located in the South Atlantic coast, bordering Namibia to the south, the Democratic Republic of Congo to the north and east, Zambia to the east, and the Atlantic Ocean to the west. The enclave of Cabinda province has borders with the Republic of Congo and the Democratic Republic of Congo. The city of Angola capital Luanda and the greater.

Climate

Angola has a tropical climate. average temperature during the dry season (May to October) is 26 ° C and the hot rainy season (November to April) maximum temperature of 33 ° C in March. Minimum temperature is 17°C in July.

The local currency is the Kwanza (Kz). According to local law, please be aware that a non-resident traveler in Angola can enter and leave the country with local currency Kz 50,000 Kwanzas, formerly equivalent to US \$

500 (official rate set by the Central Bank - BNA). The rate is subject to fluctuations. Non-resident traveler can also enter / exit the country with foreign currency not exceeding the equivalent of US \$ 5,000.00.

Airport

After getting a bus will take you to the arrivals hall. In this area you will find immigration authorities will ask you to present your passport with a valid visa. Be patient, friendly and cooperative, as it may take some time.

Read the information as it indicates where each passport holders should proceed to (diplomats, foreign and domestic). There is a new area left for the beneficiary countries visa on arrival.

If unchecked, then you should proceed to the baggage collection point.

Once you have collected your luggage, then you will face customs officer if you have any goods to declare. If you are not ready to proceed to the arrivals hall before leaving the airport. Agencies usually arrange airport pick-ups. However, it is advisable to know how to get in touch with your contact point or any other colleague in the case of this agreement is not in place.

taxis:

Patronize only licensed taxis. taxis without local license are unreliable, and should be avoided. Sometimes, some taxi drivers can temper with the meter to overload. If there is no agreement on the amount in advance. The rate from the airport to the center of various city, but should not exceed 6000 Kz. Some companies have a fixed rate. Please get informed in advance.

General Security Situation

Essentially, Luanda is a fairly quiet town. However, like all other cities around the world, it is susceptible to crime and other security issues and related security. In 2018 theft (the most common type of crime) with the use of lethal objects, including firearms they were observed. Although it is visible the efforts of the authorities to reduce the crime rate and to fulfill its duty to maintain law and order, they are advised to be extra cautious and follow the recommendations under security alert. *

hazards:

The most significant danger is traffic accidents (RTA). RTA was evaluated as the second most common cause of death among adults, malaria follows. Although it has also affected UN personnel the risk associated with this threat is low.

*** Safety Alert:**

Targets are selected either randomly or by any other reason.

Thefts are the most common type of crime. They can happen at any time of day and anywhere while walking in electronic boxes, traffic jams etc.

Each criminal situation is unique, and therefore must be treated individually. When you are faced with the criminal situation, try to stay calm. You must quickly weigh your options and decide the best response should be.

The answers include:

1. *Non-resistance*
2. *Cooperating with the aggressor*
3. *Evasion*
4. *Physically take the offender*

In most cases, non-resistance proved the best option to prevent damage.

hotels:

There is a good reasonable accommodation. However, Rental / Lodging prices are high. There are a number of hotels and guest houses, which offer acceptable services. Most booking hotel reservations need to be secured with payment. It is advisable to request a reservation be made locally, although other forms of payment may viable and the whole process done by yourself at your end.

- *Never leave your luggage unattended.*
- *Always store valuables in the safe.*
- *Keep your room locked at all times*
- *If someone knocks, check who it is before opening the door.*
- *Familiarize yourself with emergency / exit procedure.*
- *Be especially careful with people loitering around the hotel.*
- *Catch is awake waiting inside the hotel until the driver / person arrives.*

Nationals of 61 countries traveling to Angola should be granted visas on arrival (please confirm individually due to some problems that occurred in practice).

We request that is made contact embassies and consulates in the country of residence to obtain a visa.

Visitors will have to present proof of accommodation and means of subsistence for the tourist visa in Luanda. The international vaccination certificate, a return ticket and a valid passport will also be required for the visa of 30 days.

Africa

Botswana, Mauritius, Namibia, Seychelles, Zimbabwe, South Africa, Algeria, Madagascar, Malawi, Morocco, Lesotho, Swaziland and Zambia.

America

Argentina, Canada, Chile, Cuba, the United States, Uruguay and Venezuela.

The Middle East and Asia:

Israel, UAE, China, South Korea, India, Indonesia, Japan and Singapore.

European states of Northern Ireland, Iceland, Monaco, Norway, United Kingdom, Russia, Switzerland and the Vatican.

Other beneficiaries include the 28 States of the European Union and countries of the Portuguese language pack nationals of Australia, New Zealand and East Timor will also be granted the visa of Angola on arrival.
